News.

Thomas Dadford

As stated in the last Newsletter, our trip boat, 'Thomas Dadford' is in Starline's boatyard in Upton-upon-Severn having a complete overhaul. Latest news from Starline is that they are experiencing a few problems with the new windows because the original openings were rusty so they had to cut away the rust to get to sound metal, hence making the openings larger. New windows are being made to size and will not be delivered until the end of June. Starline are suggesting a completion date of about the 12th July so hopefully we will be up and running in time for the school holidays. A new engine will be sourced and fitted locally.

Grants and Donations.

As mentioned in the last Newsletter, a number of grants and donations had been received which enabled us to complete the planned refurbishment of the 'Thomas Dadford'. Our thanks go the following organisations for their very generous help –

Y Gronfa Wledig – £8,000 - a scheme partly funded by the European Union through the Rural Development Plan for Wales; Welsh Churches Act Fund - £2,000; Western Power Distribution plc - £1,000; Skewen Congregational Church - £1,000.

Work Parties.

One Work Party was held recently – at Aberdulais Basin to cut down a tree which was leaning over the canal. The area around the Skew Bridge was also cleaned up.

Tennant Canal.

A new footbridge has been installed over the Tennant Canal near Jersey Marine village to replace the one removed by the Tennant Canal Company some time ago for Health and Safety reasons. This will enable walkers to again walk from Jersey Marine to Neath Abbey.

Neath Canal – Towpath Closure.

The towpath on the Neath Canal between B&Q and Bridge Street in Neath Town Centre will be closed for approx. 17 weeks due to work being carried out on the railway bridge which crosses the canal at this point.

Family History Day.

The Trust had a stall at the Family History Day which was held at the Waterfront Museum, Swansea on Saturday 22^{nd} May. A number of people showed an interest in the canal and the work that the Trust is doing. Many thanks to Mike Jones and Ian Milne for manning the stall all day.
